By Car: Note that parking on site is very limited so it is advised that you park at one of the following car parks, which are located within walking distance.

Rupert Street NCP Bristol, BS1 2PY (5 minutes walking), Trenchard Street BCC Bristol, BS1 5AN (5 minutes walking), Prince Street NCP Bristol, BS1 4PH (15 minutes walking), Lower Castle Street NCP Bristol, BS1 3AF (15 minutes walking), Queen Charlotte Street NCP Bristol, BS1 4ES (15 minutes walking).

By Train: Bristol Temple Meads station is approximately 30 minutes' walk from the Education Centre. A taxi is advised (approximately £9).
