Where is Keble College?

Keble College is situated on the northern edge of Oxford city centre, just off Banbury Road and the northern end of St Giles. It is opposite the University science area and the University Parks. Find it on the University of Oxford's searchable maps. There is excellent disabled access throughout the conference facilities

Getting to the College

Travelling by rail: the railway station is approximately 20 minutes' walk from Keble College. Taxi services are available outside the Station entrance. For rail travel information ring +44 (0)8457 484950 or visit the Network Rail website.

Travel by car: parking is very limited in Oxford and there are only 2 hour restricted bays outside of the college. Use of the Oxford park and ride system is strongly advised (https://www.oxford.gov.uk/parkandridesites)
