Upon archiving, your membership will be anonymised, and all your personal data will be permanently deleted.

Neither the BSCI / BSCCT nor Fitwise Management Ltd, as the BSCI / BSCCT Secretariat, will supply your personal data to any third party except where expressed permission has been given by you or where / when required for the sole purpose of organising the BSCI / BSCCT Membership.

The right to forget or anonymise your personal details:

You retain the right to request that we forget or anonymize your personal data. Please note, not giving or withdrawing consent will result in your BSCI / BSCCT membership application not being processed.

Terms and Condition of Membership of the BSCI / BSCCT*

BSCI / BSCCT Constitution Article 4:

- Membership shall be open to all Clinicians practicing cardiovascular imaging, who have paid the annual subscription.
- Associate membership should be open to all medical trainees and non-medical personnel involved in cardiovascular imaging who have paid the annual subscription. This will be set at 50% of the membership fee. Associate members will pay a reduced fee to attend BSCI/BSCCT meetings.

BSCI / BSCCT Constitution Article 5:

The subscription shall be fixed by the Executive Committee from time to time and shall be payable on the 1st January annually to the Treasurer.

Any member who fails to pay his subscription by 1st July in the same year shall forfeit membership.
